The sloped sides and back splash deter ligature, and its robust mounting bracket is ideal for both retrofit and new design. It easily replaces other sinks (or can be used in new installations) and is designed to support additional weight by interlocking our companion trap cover with the sink. It accepts all standard faucets as well as our patented BSP faucets. Comes standard with ligature resistant trap cover and all mounting hardware. Installation, Maintenance, & Operation Instructions

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

The BSP sink is designed for maximum strength and stability. The extra heavy duty mounting plate is designed to fasten directly onto blocking in the wall so there is no "guessing" as to whether you are anchoring into the blocking properly.

- **1** The optimum ADA install height for the rim of the sink is usually 34" however it's always good to check your local code. (If the previous sink was at a lower position then you may need to raise the waste and supply to the ADA height) If you determine that 34" is the height you want to use, center the backing plate (the one with studs) over the waste. Set the height of the top of the bracket at 34-1/2" and mark the wall around the perimeter with a pencil or marker.
- 2 Cut and remove gypsum board from the marked area down to the studs so the plate can fit against the studs.
- **3** Install blocking as necessary between studs. Full 2x6 fire-treated wood is recommended. Heavy sheet metal blocking may be used, however be sure to use appropriate fasteners.

- **4** Hold the backing plate in place being sure it is level and install with screws provided or appropriate screws for your blocking. We recommend at least four screws on the top line and two on the bottom.
- **5** Hold the sink over the exposed 3/8" studs, place cover plate over the sink back, install flat washers, lock washers and nuts. (Caution -do not over tighten 3/8" nuts, only compress lock washers-Over tightening could pull the blocking out of the wall)
- 6 Install drain/trap/faucet and related plumbing components.
- **7** Install the trap cover to the bottom of the sink using the small machine screws.
- **8** Mark the holes through the trap cover on the wall. Remove the trap cover and install the screw- in wall anchors in the drywall.
- **9** Reinstall the trap cover with the screws in the sink and then the screws in the wall.


The install is complete. We also recommend using a pick free caulk to caulk the sink to the wall.






