

#WR800 LIGATURE RESISTANT WASTE RECEPTACLE

Installation, Maintenance & Operational Instructions

Our ligature resistant waste receptacle is designed uniquely for our customers to keep the waste inside and the patients out. The rounded corners and angled top deter ligature while maintaining a sleek aesthetic appearance. The plastic waste receptacle is secured within the 14GA steel construction, behind a double lock door. The inlet and down-chute are sized to accept most plastic bottles or Styrofoam cups and long enough to keep patients from "reaching" the trash. There is a lockable clean-out door, should waste get stuck in the chute. It should be secured to the floor and against a wall. The perimeter sealed with pick free caulk.




Product Layout





Installation Instructions


- 1. Set the Waste Receptacle on the floor and against a wall. Ensure the location is capable of safely supporting the product in use. Use pencil to mark the location of the 4 floor mounting holes for the Tapcon Masonry Anchors. Move the Waste Receptacle out of the way and using the ½" Masonry Bit and Hammer Drill, drill the 4 holes at the marks. Clean up concrete dust.
- 2. Relocate Waste Receptacle over drill holes. Start the Tapcon Anchors with a washer in the drilled holes; do not tighten yet. Push Waste Receptacle flush against the wall.
- 3. Add shims under Waste Receptacle to fill gaps between bottom and floor. Tighten Tapcon Floor Anchors.
- 4. Caulk around the floor anchors on the inside of the can to prevent liquids from getting under the can. Caulk around the bottom of the can and install no pick caulk at the top of the can.





Basic Use Instructions

- 1. The Waste Receptacle comes with 2 sets of different barrel keys. One is larger than the other. The larger set is for the "PLASTIC TRASH RECEPTACLE ACCESS DOOR". The smaller is for the "WASTE CHUTE CLEAN-OUT DOOR".
- 2. To access Plastic Trash Receptacle, unlock the two locks on the Door (shown). Open the Door fully. The Plastic Trash Receptacle can now be pulled out.
- 3. Replace the Plastic Trash Receptacle. Close the Door and lock the Barrel Lock. Check security of locked door.





Basic Use Instructions (continued)

- 4. To access Waste Chute, unlock the one smaller lock on the Waste Chute Clean-out Door (shown). Open the Door fully. The Chute can be cleaned out as needed.
- 5. Close the Door and lock the Barrel Lock remove the key. Check security of locked door.
